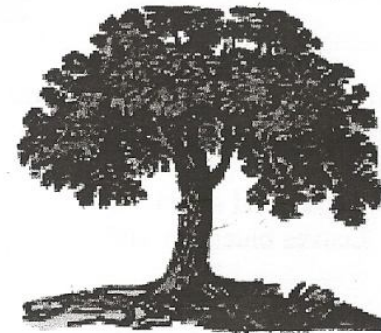

1. **Common Lime** – *Tilia europaea*.

Native region Europe grows to 40 metres in height grey bark with shallow fissures. Leaves green heart shaped.



2. **Maidenhair Tree** – *Ginkgo biloba*.

Native region China, grows to 40 metres in height grey/brown bark with ridges. Leaves fan shaped with a large centre notch.



3. **Turkish Hazel** - *Corylus colurna*.

Native region Asia and Europe, grows to 25 metres in Height. Bark grey and corky. Leaves broadly oval and rough to the touch.



4. **Silver Gum** – *Eucalyptus cordata*.

Native region Tasmania, grows to 15 metres in height. Bark smooth with white, grey and green patches. Leaves blue/grey and ovate.



5. **Norway Maple** – *Acer platanoides*.

Native region Asia and Europe, grows to 25 metres in height. Bark grey and smooth. Leaves palmately lobed with “helicopter” seeds



6. **Silver Birch** – *Betula pendula*.

Native region Asia and Europe, grows to 30 metres in height. Bark white/silver peeling away from stem. Leaves green and triangular.



7. **Dawn Redwood** – *Metasequoia spp*

Native region China, grows to 40 metres in height. Orange/brown bark peeling vertically in stringy flakes. Leaves dark green needles with a spiral growth pattern



8. **Blue Atlas Cedar** – *Cedrus atlantica*

Native region Algeria and Morocco, grows to 40 metres in height, dark grey bark with scaly plates. Leaves needle-like in dense whorls.



9. **Holm Oak** – *Quercus ilex*.

Native region Mediterranean, grows to 30 metres in height, bark almost black with cracks. Leaves dark green and slender.



10. **Tree of Heaven** – *Ailanthus altissima*.

Native region China, grows to 20 metres in height, bark grey/brown with pale streaks. Leaves pinnate and glossy green.



11. **Maritime Pine** – *Pinus pinaster*.

Native region Africa and Europe, grows to 35 metres in height, bark purple/brown with ridges and fissures. Leaves needle-like and stiff.



12. **Stone Pine** – *Pinus pinea*.

Native region Mediterranean, grows to 20 metres in height, bark orange/brown with deep fissures. Leaves needle-like and stout with glossy brown cone.



13. **Himalayan Birch** – *betula utilis*.

Native region Himalayas and China, grows to 25 metres in height, bark orange/brown, pink to pure white and is paper-thin. Leaves glossy green toothed.



14. **Judas Tree** - *Cercis siliquastrum*.

Native region Asia and Europe, grows to 10 metres in height, bark grey/brown with small square plates. Leaves rounded smooth and dark blue/green.



15. **Wych Elm** – *Ulmus glabra*.

Native region Asia and Europe, grows to 40 metres in height, grey/brown ridged bark. Leaves dark green and toothed.



16. **Indian Bean Tree** – *Catalap bignonioides*.

Native region United States, grows to 15 metres in height, grey/brown scaly bark. Leaves large green and ovate.



17. **English Oak** – *Quercos robur*.

Native region Europe, grows to 35 metres in height, bark is pale grey and fissured. Leaves green with 3-6 lobes and acorns.



18. **Sycamore** – *Acer pseudoplatanus*.

Native region Asia and Europe, grows to 30 metres in height, bark pinkish to yellow/grey with plates. Leaves coarsely toothed dark green palmate with “helicopter” seeds.
